The Department of Counseling proposes to change the name of the Ph.D. program in the Department of Counseling from “Ph.D. in Counseling” to “Ph.D. in Counselor Education and Supervision.”

At the present time, most doctoral programs in counseling have the name “Counselor Education and Supervision,” and this name change would align our program’s name with the name of our doctoral level accreditation by the Council for the Accreditation of Counseling and Other Related Programs (CACREP).
